Over the next couple of months, there are many things that you can do to participate in the workings of your neighborhood.

Consider running for the Board of Trustees – There are four (4) vacancies to fill this year. You may have some skills that would be put to good use by volunteering. The commitment is for 2 years. The positions are strictly voluntary. Trustees work anywhere from 5 - ?? hours a month. Each trustee is assigned a managerial responsibility to oversee. You can find the application form and some helpful information about running for one of the open positions on the website or at the office. Think about it. Each year we request input from the community to suggest amendments to the bylaws. Our bylaws are undergoing some major revisions this year to make sure we are aligned with RCW 64.38 which provides consistent laws regarding the legal administration of HOAs. Forms and bylaw information is available on the website and at the office. The board reviews all proposals and then forwards them to the attorney for review. **Proposals are due in the office or by email by 4:30 pm on March 15, 2024.** 

Several committees are forming or expanding right now. CBHA needs to run like a small town. A small commitment of your time can help keep things running smoothly. The more participation we have from our members, the better we can serve the entire community.
