The launch gate lock will be changed on Friday, July 1. To avoid having a key that does not work after that, members who currently hold a launch gate key may pick up a new key and fill out the new lease beginning **June 20**. Old launch gate keys must be returned to the office no later than August 1. The cost for the new launch gate key will be \$ 20. Members who wish to get a launch gate key who do not currently have one will be charged a fee of \$25.00. Also, please note that there is a \$25.00 fee to replace a lost key, or a key not turned in by August 1.
