#### Reminder for Dog Owners: Dogs must be kept on leash or controlled by their owner 24/7 in the community. We have had numerous reports of loose dogs, dogs being walked off-leash, and dog attacks in the last month. Please control your pets at all times! We need to be respectful of everyone's safety and right to enjoy their yards, our streets and the parks. Dogs noted to be offleash or dogs that attack other humans and pets will be subject to CBHA rules and applicable fines.

**Tree Maintenance:** As we approach the stormy season, please make sure you remove any dead trees from your property and check larger trees for any hanging limbs. Reducing damage to your home and other properties is important with incoming rains and winds!

Winter Reminders: If traveling during the winter and your home will be unoccupied, remember to set your heat to at least 60 degrees. This will help prevent pipe bursts during extremely cold weather. Please check your emergency kits and ensure you have a stock of emergency food, flashlights, and batteries. Check your generators and remember to check on your neighbors during an emergency!

As we move from fall to winter, we always deal with some unexpected weather in the Pacific Northwest! Below are some maintenance items to consider as we head into the winter months:

- Clean and inspect gutters
- Inspect your roof
- Winterize any outdoor plumbing
- Trim trees
- Store outdoor items
- Service furnaces and heat pumps
- Reverse ceiling fans
- Clean dryer vents
- Check smoke and carbon monoxide detectors
- Check fireplaces and chimneys

We also recommend making sure you have everything you need for any weather emergencies this winter. Ensuring your generators are tuned up or you have spare batteries, portable heaters etc. can go a long way to being prepared.

The Board would like to thank the marina committee and other owner volunteers that are helping to shoo away sealions from our marina. We appreciate the work being done to help protect our newly repaired common assets.

Our community has experienced an uptick in vehicle vandalism. Please remain vigilant and report any suspicious activity to local law enforcement.


