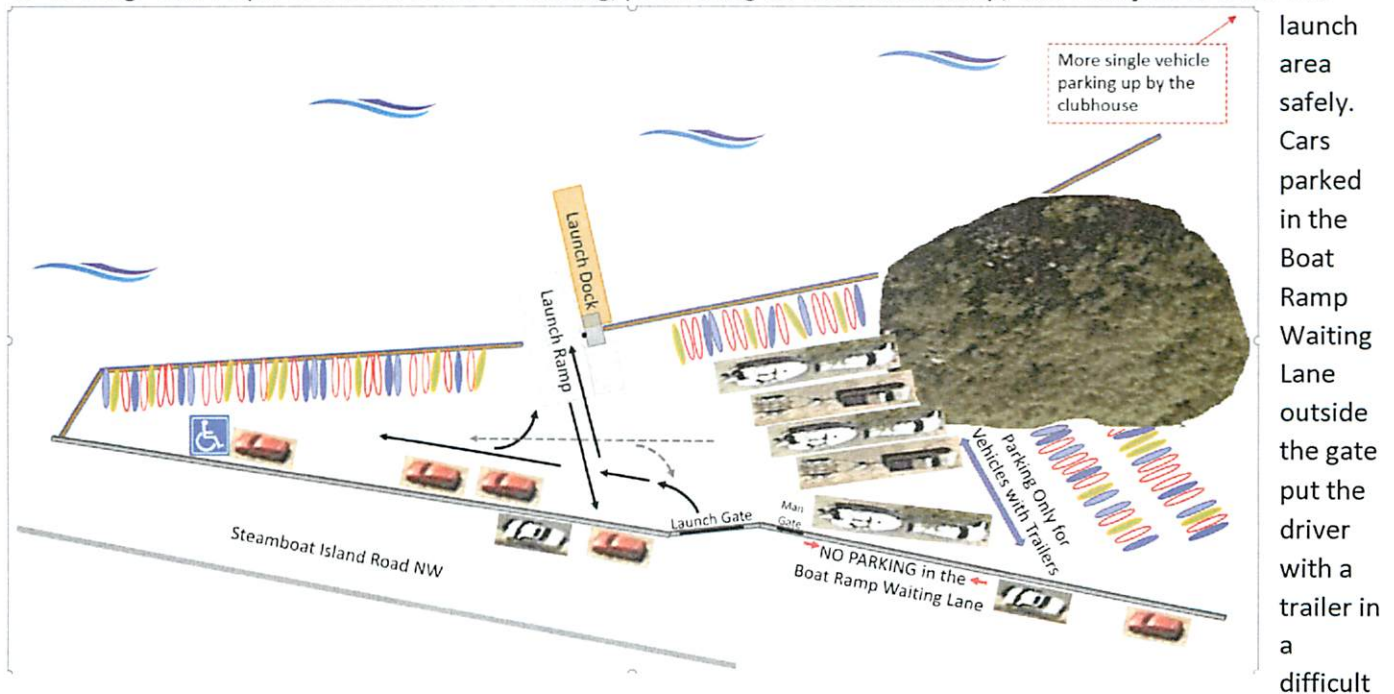
LAUNCH GATE KEY TO CHANGE

The launch gate lock will be changed on Monday July 1st. To avoid having a key that does not work after that, members who currently hold a launch gate key may pick up a new key and fill out the new lease beginning June 17. Old launch gate keys must be returned to the Office no later than August 1. The cost for the new launch gate key will be \$ 20. Members who wish to get a launch gate key who do not currently have one will be charged a fee of \$25.00. Also, please note that there is a \$25.00 fee to replace a lost key, or a key not turned in by August 1.

We are installing new signs to replace the faded ones, to help everyone have a great time on the water.

Both boaters and kayakers need to use the launch area to access the water, and sometimes there are misunderstandings. This article hopes to clear up some of those. A vehicle with a boat trailer can be roughly 35' to 45' long. This requires a lot of room for turning, positioning for the launch ramp, and even just to enter the



position as they try to get through the gate without damaging parked cars. For this reason, the **Boat Ramp Waiting Lane** will be clearly marked as a no parking zone. Single vehicles can park behind the waiting lane or ahead of the gate itself, as shown on the attached diagram.

Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays, no vehicles without trailers will be allowed to park in the launch area, except for the **disabled parking spot**. Parking for trailer rigs is so limited. Vehicles with trailers are not allowed in the upper parking lot without special permission, so the launch area is their only option. Note the arrows on the diagram. The solid arrows show how a rig must pull in when there are already trailers parked in a row on the right. Many adjustments are needed to back into the launch area. It needs to be clear north of the ramp so the boat trailer can begin backing down the launch ramp. They may have to pull forward to keep the boat straight for backing in. The dotted arrows show the space needed for a parked vehicle with a trailer to just back up enough to turn out the gate. Single vehicles coming in to drop off or pick up kayakers need to be mindful of this, and give the trailers room. Even on quiet weekdays, single vehicles should park along the fence only, & not across from the ramp, under the tree, as that space is needed for positioning to launch. Leave the vehicle/trailer spaces to the trailers.

Some boaters have complained about kayakers using the launch area. Some kayakers have reported issues with boaters. Please remember we are all members using our launch, and watch out for each other. Kayakers need to use the launch to access the water as do boaters. While kayakers can carry their boats to the waterline in low tide conditions, boaters must have high water to safely launch. Each of us, boater or kayaker, needs to launch & move out of the way of the next person as quickly as safely possible. Wait for friends out of the launch area. **And don't forget to have fun, everyone!**
